

2003-20 4Runner/ 07-14 FJ Cruiser/ 05-20 Tacoma

RCI A-Arm Skid Plate Installation

1. Universal Hardware packet includes hardware for 05-20 Tacoma, 03-20 4Runner or 07-14 FJ. **Please see install notes for hardware that will NOT be used on your specific model.**
2. Lift front of vehicle with jacks or ramps, and safely secure it if extra working room is necessary.
3. Before starting installation, insert 3/8" carriage bolts through skid plate and secure them with the 3/8" retainers. The shorter of the two carriage bolts will be at the front of skid (toward welded flange). Use a deep socket or similar and tap them on with a hammer. The retainers are not critical but will make install and removal much easier for one person.
4. Lift A-arm skid plate into position and install washers, lock-washers, and nuts (on top of A-arm, leaving loose enough to adjust plate position).
5. Adjust as necessary, then install 1/4" hex bolt through the elongated slot near the tire. Install fender washers on both sides and locknut on top of A-arm. Make sure that there is adequate clearance between CV boot and bolt threads, even at full droop (suspension fully extended). If needed the bolt can be installed upside down, but must be installed while the vehicle is on the ground.
6. Adjust plate as necessary then fully tighten all bolts and locknuts.
7. Repeat steps for opposite A-arm skid plate.

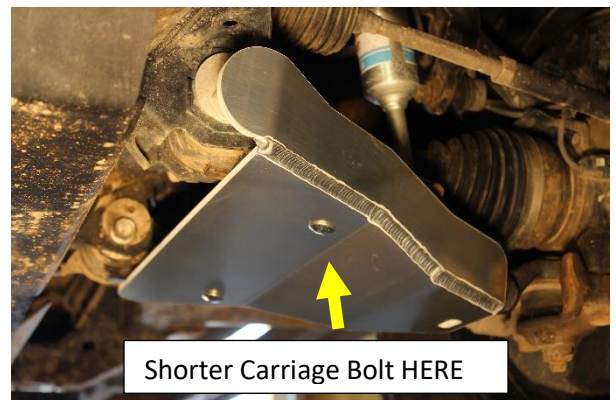
